News from NCFRW

The winter meeting of the NCFRW was held in February in Raleigh. We were well represented at the meeting.

Two resolutions came out of the deliberations: A resolution thanking and commending Elizabeth Dole for her work as our Senator and a resolution thanking George W. Bush and Laura Bush for their contributions to America. Both passed unanimously.

State Legislative Report

- Marriage Amendment Priority #1—There will be a rally 3/3/2009, 11:00 am in Halifax Hall, NC State Capital in Raleigh—let's get a large vocal group to join with other Republican Clubs.
- Fetal Homicide Bill—bills have been filed in both Houses—we are one of very few states that do not have a law calling for double homicide when the woman is pregnant.

Federal Legislative Report

- Freedom of Choice Act, better known as FOCA. This law will virtually overturn any restrictions on abortion in all 50 states.
- Card Check is a Democrat payback to Unions who elected them. It will take away the ability of employees to cast a secret ballot whether to unionize or not. They will simply check a card yes or no.

Notes From The MRW Board

The Board of Directors at their February meeting took the following actions:

- Voted to support the voter I.D. proposal and to distribute petitions to be presented to the legislature. This will be a statewide Club action.
- Voted to apply for a bank credit card through Bank 1 where we have our account.
- Voted to approve a proposal by the Moore Republican Men's Club to join with them in a fund raiser to hold a bridge tournament on June 9th at the Whispering Pines Country Club.
