Election implications and one more push for the U.S. Senate!

North Carolina had a good night on November 8, as you can see from the results <u>here</u>. North Carolina Republicans **won the two state Supreme Court races** and the four North Carolina Court of Appeals races, flipping the NC Supreme Court from a 4-3 Democratic majority to a 5-2 Republican majority.

In addition, Republicans won a 30-seat supermajority in the 50-member **NC Senate** but fell one seat short in the 120-member NC House. A little disappointing but still well worth celebrating - and Moore County especially was a big winner, electing our Republican Commissioners and gaining a strong, conservative School board!

But the Red Wave across the country did not materialize, so we're fighting for the Senate. In Georgia, Herschel Walker will be in a runoff against Raphael Warnock on December 6 (the day before Pearl Harbor Day, when the US was attacked). The US is under attack again, this time by the Left.
