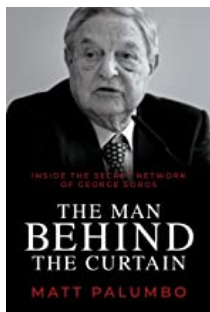
There is also a mail-in form [here](#) if you prefer; however you cannot specify the Sandhills Veterans Cemetery with checks that are mailed in.
